Security fixes:

- Phishing attack via email verification step in first login flow (CVE-2025-7365)
- Privilege Escalation in Keycloak Admin Console (FGAPv2 Enabled) (CVE-2025-7784)

## Solution

Before applying the update, back up your existing installation, including all applications, configuration files, databases and database settings, and so on.
