Red Hat build of Keycloak 26.0.15 is a standalone server, based on the Keycloak project, that provides authentication and standards-based single sign-on capabilities for web and mobile applications.

Security fixes:

- Variable injection into environment variables (CVE-2025-9162)
- Keycloak SMTP Inject Vulnerability (CVE-2025-8419)

## Solution

Before applying the update, back up your existing installation, including all applications, configuration files, databases and database settings, and so on.


