



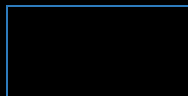

To prevent being affected by this vulnerability on vulnerable versions, please turn off the FortiCloud login feature (if enabled) temporarily until upgrading to a non-affected version.

To turn off FortiCloud login, go to System → Settings → Switch "Allow administrative login using FortiCloud SSO" to Off. Or type the following command in the CLI:

```
config system global
set admin-forticloud-sso-login disable
end
```
