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## Topic

An update for gnutls is now available for Red Hat Enterprise Linux 9.

## Description

The gnutls packages provide the GNU Transport Layer Security (GnuTLS) library, which implements cryptographic algorithms and protocols such as SSL, TLS, and DTLS.
