An update for xorg-x11-server is now available for Red Hat Enterprise Linux 9.

Description

X.Org is an open-source implementation of the X Window System. It provides the basic low-level functionality that full-fledged graphical user interfaces are designed upon.



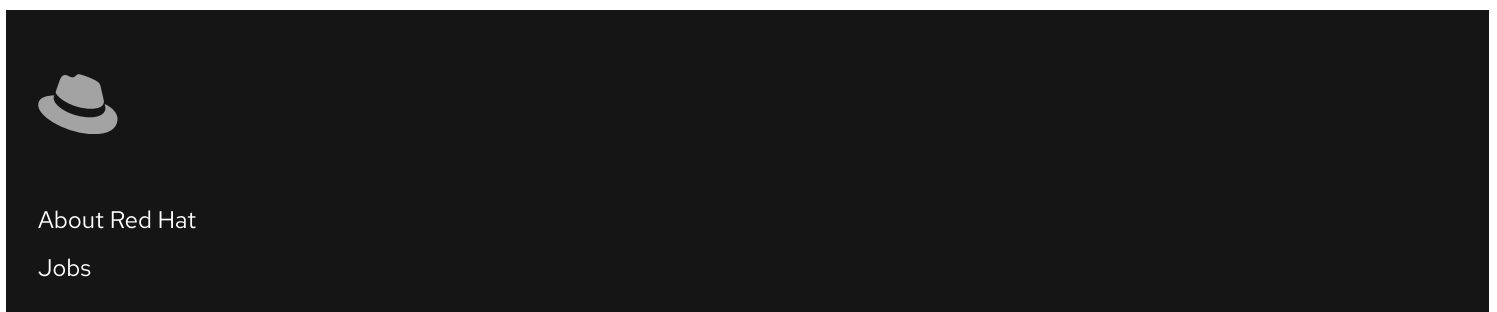
