| Vulnerability Description | A stack buffer overflow vulnerability has been reported in Sysax Multi Server SSH Service.  |
| Vulnerability Details     | The vulnerability is due to a boundary error when processing authentication requests. A remote attacker can exploit this issue by sending a specially crafted authentication request to the target. Successful exploitation would allow an attacker to inject and execute arbitrary code on the target. |

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
