Description

Improperly built order clauses lead to a SQL injection vulnerability in the articles webservice endpoint.

Affected Installs

Joomla! CMS versions 4.0.0-5.4.3, 6.0.0-6.0.3

Solution

Upgrade to version 5.4.4 or 6.0.4
