This vulnerability is moderately dangerous and expected to become exploited. Vulnerabilities like this one are used in mass-exploit campaigns. Attackers use these

As immediate action, update the affected plugin. If you're unable to do so, ask your hosting provider or web developer for help.

i User Interaction Required

While this vulnerability can be initiated by the role shown in "Required Privilege", successful exploitation requires a privileged user to perform an action — such as clicking a malicious link, visiting a crafted page, or submitting a form.

5.9 Cross Site Scripting

This could allow an attacker to inject arbitrary HTML and JavaScript code into the page, which will be executed when the page is viewed.

CVSS score is a way to measure the severity of a vulnerability, but it is not ideal for WordPress.

Automatically mitigate vulnerabilities and keep your websites safe.

Patchstack has issued a mitigation rule to block any attacks until an official patch becomes available, can be tested and be safely applied.
