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## Security Bulletin: HCL DevOps Velocity is susceptible to brute-force attacks

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### Summary

HCL DevOps Velocity is susceptible to brute-force attacks.

### Vulnerability Details

**CVEID:** CVE-2025-31991

**DESCRIPTION:** Rate Limiting for attempting a user login is not being properly enforced, making HCL DevOps Velocity susceptible to brute-force attacks past the unsuccessful login attempt limit. This vulnerability is fixed in 5.1.7.

**CVSS Base score:** 6.8

**CVSS Vector:** CVSS:3.1/AV:N/AC:L/PR:H/UI:N/S:C/C:N/I:H/A:N

## Affected products and versions

HCL DevOps Velocity version < 5.1.7

## Remediation/fixes

HCL strongly suggests the following:

Upgrade the affected versions to 5.1.7 or later from My HCLSoftware Portal.
