Summary

A vulnerability classified as **critical** was found in **Belkin F9K1015 1.00.10**. Impacted is the function `formReboot` of the file `/goform/formReboot`. The manipulation of the argument `webpage` results in stack-based overflow. This vulnerability is cataloged as **CVE-2026-5613**. The attack may be launched remotely. Furthermore, there is an exploit available. The vendor was contacted early about this disclosure but did not respond in any way.

Details

A vulnerability, which was classified as critical, was found in **Belkin F9K1015 1.00.10**. Affected is the function `formReboot` of the file `/goform/formReboot`. The manipulation of the argument `webpage` with an unknown input leads to a stack-based overflow vulnerability. CWE is classifying the issue as **CWE-121**. A stack-based buffer overflow condition is a condition where the buffer being overwritten is allocated on the stack (i.e., is a local variable or, rarely, a parameter to a function). This is going to have an impact on confidentiality, integrity, and availability.

The advisory is shared for download at github.com. This vulnerability is traded as **CVE-2026-5613**. The exploitability is told to be easy. It is possible to launch the attack remotely. Technical details and a public exploit are known.

The exploit is shared for download at github.com. It is declared as proof-of-concept. The vendor was contacted early about this disclosure but did not respond in any way.

There is no information about possible countermeasures known. It may be suggested to replace the affected object with an alternative product.

The entry **VDB-351074** is related to this item.
