



# Security Bulletin: IBM Content Navigator is affected by CVE-2026-1243, a Cross-Site Scripting (XSS) vulnerability

## Security Bulletin

### Summary

IBM Content Navigator is affected by CVE-2026-1243, a Cross-Site Scripting (XSS) vulnerability that allows an authenticated user to embed arbitrary JavaScript into the Web UI. This could alter intended application behaviour and potentially lead to credentials disclosure within a trusted session. This vulnerability carries a CVSS v3.1 score of 5.4 (Medium) and requires low privileges and user interaction to exploit.

### Vulnerability Details

**DESCRIPTION:** IBM Content Navigator is vulnerable to cross-site scripting. This vulnerability allows an authenticated user to embed arbitrary JavaScript code in the Web UI thus altering the intended functionality potentially leading to credentials disclosure within a trusted session.
